Our ambitions:

The development of our members and the opportunity to compete are of paramount importance to us, but are consistently limited due to financial restrictions. Our current priorities are:

- Purchase of a single scull to support members participating in University level development programmes.
- Purchase of a midweight 4+ for use by both men and women. This will allow the women to compete more frequently during Michaelmas.
- Purchase of a new set of riggers and men's blades to be used by the men's 1st VIII.
- Kit subsidy to help make the acquisition of essential training and race kit affordable for all members.
